WOC trainings 2012

Dear Team Officials,

We've conducted an opinion poll amongst the main orienteering teams of Europe and as a result of this, the organizing committee WOC2012 has decided to change the dates of the training camp in June. This training will now take place after the World Cup in St-Gallen, from 25 to 30 June 2012 and not as announced in bulletin n°2 from 18 to 22 June. See the attached programme.

The dates on which we are allowed to use the different maps are laid down in an agreement with the Service of the Forests of the Canton Vaud. In order for us to maintain access to these forests for future orienteering events (once the World Championships are over), no changes will be permitted to the specified dates.

The course planners of WOC 2012 will prepare the training courses to avoid the forbidden and ecologically sensitive areas in close collaboration with the person responsible for the environment. The controls will be put out on the days of training only. The printed maps will be sold to you according to your requests, provided they are received within the deadlines. The maps will be given to the teams one week before the training. Training will only be possible on the fixed dates and on the printed courses.

Other training opportunities exist in the Canton Bern, Fribourg and Neuchâtel according to the enclosed list. The relevant clubs are responsible for selling their own maps, and defining on which days training events can be held. The WOC committee is not responsible for these training events.

Additional information about Embargoed Areas for WOC 2012

The organizers of WOC2012 would like to add the following text to the embargoed areas published in Bulletin 2 on pages 12 & 13. All potential WOC2012 team members (runners, coaches, doctors, team leaders etc.) or any other person who could influence the results of the competitions by knowledge of the terrain, are not allowed to enter the embargoed areas. It is permissible to pass through the embargoed areas using paved public roads marked with light red or yellow background on the maps in Bulletin 2 (pages 12 & 13). No other roads may be used. The embargoed areas remain unchanged.
